Dr TSANG was widely respected as a prominent figure in the dentistry field in Hong Kong and across the Asia Pacific. Dr TSANG, being one of the distinguished students supported by Government scholarship to pursue dental training abroad, had registered as a dentist in Hong Kong since 28 June 1960. Dr TSANG has also devoted himself practising in the field of Orthodontics throughout his notable career.

Dr TSANG served as the Chairman of the Council from 1988 to 2006, guiding the Council during a period of significant growth and development. As a pivotal figure in the establishment of a statue-based Specialist Register, his vision and dedication to enhance the standards of dental practice have transformed the profession, fostering trust and confidence within the community.

A longstanding and renowned member of the Hong Kong Dental Association (HKDA), Dr TSANG also served as the President of the HKDA during 1972 to 1973.
