Sample Structure Simulated Viva Voce Case Part III Clinical Test of the Licensing Examination

The structured simulated viva voce examination consists of a clinical scenario and the candidate will be asked to answer some standard questions, some case-specific questions and some follow up questions which are related to any aspect of the case.

The clinical scenario presented to the candidates includes a brief medical and dental history, a series of imaging materials including photograph(s), radiograph(s) and/or chartings that are deemed essential for the interpretation of the clinical situation and the actual management of the patient.

Patient A

Patient Particulars

A 48-year-old woman complained of pain in the upper left region and requested replacement of missing teeth. The patient also complained of a dry mouth.

Medical History

She has a prosthetic heart valve and takes warfarin 5mg daily. Her INR was 2.4 when it was checked 7 days ago.

Family and Social History

She is a secondary school teacher. She is a non-smoker. She is an irregular attender at the dentist, usually only visits a dentist if she has specific problems.
